ORDINANCE NO. #1642-5-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF AVILLA, INDIANA, REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF A NEW SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER UTILITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Town of Avilla, Indiana (the "Town"), owns and operates a municipal waterworks utility (the "Waterworks") and collects rates and charges for the water utility services rendered by the Waterworks; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2022, Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb signed House Enrolled Act No. 1002 ("HEA 1002") into law, which among other things, repeals the Indiana Utility Receipts Tax ("IURT"), currently codified in Ind. Code 6-2.3, with an effective date of July 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, House Enrolled Act No. 1002 requires that each rate or charge that includes recovery of the IURT be calculated to remove the amount designed to recover for the IURT; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to decrease certain existing rates and charges in order to comply with such financial requirements of HEA 1002.

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 8-1.5-3-9.1, the Town Council removed the Waterworks from jurisdiction of the Utility Regulatory Commission on October 7, 1994 for purposes of approval of rates and charges and the issuance of bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness;

WHEREAS, this Board, pursuant to IC 8-1.5-3-8 and IC 8-1.5-3-8.1, acting as the municipal legislative body, has the power, authority and responsibility to approve new rates and charges;

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed schedule of rates and charges in not required by IC 8-1.5-3-8.1(b) and IC 5-3-1 for rate decreases or compliance with state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF AVILLA, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. The following schedule of rates and charges for the water utility services listed below and rendered by the Waterworks of the Town of Avilla, Indiana, shall replace the existing rates and charges for the services listed below:
